**Minister of Education, Arts and Culture:**

That leave be given to introduce a Bill to promote and regulate free and compulsory basic education; to ensure equitable inclusive quality education and lifelong learning ; to promote and protect the right of learners to education; to provide for the establishment, accreditation, registration, governance and management of State and private schools and hostels; to provide for the establishment of the National Advisory Council on Education; the regional education forums, the National Examination, Assessment and Certification Board, the Teaching Service and the Education Development Fund; and to provide for incidental matters.
