TUESDAY, 28 FEBRUARY 2017

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **Announcement by the Speaker in terms of Rule 20(b) of the Standing Rules and Orders:**

The Speaker announced that he has been informed by the Chairperson of the National Council that the Council, in terms of Article 75(2) of the Namibian Constitution considered the *Public Private Partnership Bill* [B. 24 – 2016] and objected to the principle of the *Bill*.

This *Bill* will be placed on the Order paper for reconsideration by this Assembly as soon as possible.

5. **Ministerial Statements in terms of Rule 98 of the Standing Rules and Orders:**
- (i) The Minister of Defence made a statement urging members of the public and the media to stop practices of taking photographs and snooping on military bases and installations for reasons only known to themselves, which could be construed as a threat to such military installations.
 - (ii) The Minister of Health and Social Services reported and informed the Assembly on the suspected case of Crimean-Congo Haemorrhagic Fever that was reported to have occurred in Omaheke Region.
