WEDNESDAY, 28 MARCH 2018

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Deputy Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **Swearing-in of a new Member in terms of Rule 20(a) of the Standing Rules and Orders:**
 - (i) The Deputy Speaker welcomed Chief Justice Peter Shivute and announced that a vacancy has occurred in the National Assembly and in terms of Article 32, Sub Article 5(c), His Excellency the President has nominated Ambassador Martin Andjaba to fill the vacant position.
 - (ii) The Deputy Speaker called on Chief Justice Shivute to administer the Oath/Affirmation to Ambassador Andjaba.
 - (iii) The Chief Justice administered the Affirmation to Ambassador Andjaba.
 - (iv) The Deputy Speaker declared Ambassador Andjaba a duly nominated Member of the National Assembly.
