**THURSDAY, 12 APRIL 2018**

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **Announcement by the Speaker in terms of Rule 20(b) of the Standing Rules and Orders:**

The Speaker announced that those Members of Parliament who were invited to attend the Gabriel Simon Shokonawa Training Academy's event, named Daniel Kashikola Marathon on 14<sup>th</sup> April 2018 in Ohangwena Region, that this event has been postponed to the 5<sup>th</sup> May 2018.

3. **The Deputy Minister of Higher Education, Training and Innovation laid upon the Table:**

Annual Report of Namibia University of Science and Technology (NUST) for the year 2016.

4. **ORAL QUESTION:**

Ms. Limbo (RDP) asked the Minister of Health and Social Services (No. 13) – *Replied to.*

5. **Ms. !Nawases-Taeyele moved without notice:**

Resumption of Committee Stage – *Appropriation Bill* [B. 2 – 2018].

The Deputy Minister of Finance moved, seconded by the Deputy Minister of Home Affairs and Immigration: That the Assembly now goes into Committee.

Agreed to.

- Vote 04 – “*Auditor-General*”. Introduced by the Minister of Presidential Affairs.
- Vote 07 – “*International Relations and Cooperation*”. Introduced by the Deputy Prime Minister and also Minister of International Relations and Cooperation.
  
- Vote 01 – “*President*”. Discussed and agreed to.
- Vote 02 – “*Prime Minister*”. Discussed and agreed to.
- Vote 30 – “*Anti-Corruption Commission*”. Stands over.

Progress reported and leave granted to sit again.
