WEDNESDAY, 18 APRIL 2018

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.
2. **Summary by the Deputy Minister of Agriculture, Water and Forestry:**

The Deputy Minister presented a brief Summary on the *Reports of the Namibian Veterinary Council for the period 1 August 2015 to 31 July 2016 and 1 August 2016 to 31 July 2017*, laid upon the Table yesterday, 17 April 2018.

3. **ORAL QUESTION:**

Mr. Murorua (UDF) asked the Minister of Environment and Tourism (No. 15) – *Replied to*.

4. **Ms. !Nawases-Taeyele moved without notice:**

That the proceedings on Votes 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 of the *Appropriation Bill* be, in terms of Rule 99(c) of the Standing Rules and Orders, not interrupted if still under consideration at 17:45.

Agreed to.

5. **FIRST ORDER READ:**

Resumption of Committee Stage – *Appropriation Bill* [B. 2 – 2018].

The Deputy Minister of Finance moved, seconded by Ms. Hoffmann: That the Assembly now goes into Committee.

Agreed to.

The Deputy Chairperson of the Whole House Committee stated that when progress was reported yesterday, 17 April 2018, Votes 14, 15 and 16 had been introduced and Votes 1 to 12, 28, 30 and 31 had been agreed.

- Vote 17 – “*Urban and Rural Development*”. Introduced by the Minister.
- Vote 18 – “*Environment and Tourism*”. Introduced by the Minister.
- Vote 19 – “*Industrialisation, Trade and SME Development*”. Introduced by the Minister.

- Vote 14 – “*Labour, Industrial Relations and Employment Creation*”. Discussed and agreed to.
- Vote 15 – “*Mines and Energy*”. Discussed and agreed to.
- Vote 16 – “*Justice*”. Discussed and agreed to.

ASSEMBLY RESUMED:

Progress reported and leave granted to sit again.

6. **Reminder by the Speaker:**

The Speaker reminded the Members to attend the half day Workshop on the African Peer Review Mechanism tomorrow, 19 April 2018 in the C1 Conference Room from 09:00 – 12:30.
