TUESDAY, 13 NOVEMBER 2018

The Assembly met pursuant to the adjournment.

1. The Speaker took the Chair and read the Prayer and Affirmation.

2. **The Minister of Information and Communication Technology laid upon the Table:**

Annual Report of the Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia (CRAN) for the year 2017.

3. **The Minister of Environment and Tourism laid upon the Table:**

Annual Report of the Sustainable Development Advisory Council for the financial year 2017/2018.

4. **FIRST ORDER READ:**

Resumption of Debate on the Transformation of the SADC Parliamentary Forum into a Regional Parliament.

Question before the Assembly on Thursday, 8 November 2018, as moved by Mr. Karupu (180).

Question put: That the Motion be supported in principle, in line with the outcome of the SADC Summit.

Agreed to.

5. **SECOND ORDER READ:**

Consideration of the Committee Report on Oversight Visits to Inquire into the Security Situation at the Port of Walvis Bay, Airports and Aerodromes.

Mr. Katoma moved, seconded by Ms. Limbo: That the Report be now considered.

Agreed to.

Question put: That the Report be adopted.

Agreed to.

6. **THIRD ORDER READ:**

Committee Stage – *Basic Education Bill* [B. 4 – 2018].

The Deputy Minister of Education, Arts and Culture moved, seconded by the Minister of Defence: That the Assembly now goes into Committee.

Ms. Van den Heever and Ms. Dienda, instead of demanding a division, requested the Speaker that their opposition to the Bill to proceed into Committee Stage be formally recorded in terms of Rule 78 of the Standing Rules and Orders.

Agreed to.

ASSEMBLY IN COMMITTEE:

Clauses 1, 3 and 12 as amended by the Deputy Minister, put and agreed to.
Clauses 2, 4 – 11 put and agreed to.

ASSEMBLY RESUMED:

Progress reported and leave given to sit again.
