3.0 NOTICE OF MOTION(S)

3.1 Hon. Shilenga moved a motion without notice: That the proceedings on **Votes 08, 06, 23, 31** and **13** of the *Appropriation Bill* [B.2 – 2018] be, in accordance with Rule 26 of the Standing Rules and Orders of the National Council, not interrupted if still under consideration at 13:00 hours.

3.2 Hon. Katamelo gave notice: That on Tuesday, 22 May 2018, he shall move the Report on 138th Assemblies and Related Meetings of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) held in Geneva, Switzerland from 24 - 28 March 2018.

3.3 Hon. Shilenga gave notice: That on Monday, 21 May 2018, he shall move the Report of the National Council Standing Committee on Security, Constitutional and Legal Affairs
