The Council met pursuant to adjournment.

1.0 The Vice - Chairperson took the Chair.

2.0 The Vice - Chairperson read the Prayer and Affirmation.

3.0 NOTICE OF MOTION(S)

Hon. Dukeleni, moved, in terms of Rule 51(1)(i), a motion without notice that the *Financial Services Adjudicator Bill* [B.10 - 2018] be recommitted to the Committee of the Whole Council. Further moved that such recommitment be done in accordance with Rule 125 of the Standing Rules and Orders, that provides that a Bill which was previously referred to a Committee, may be recommitted to a Committee in part or as a whole. Therefore, the motion seeks to recommit the *Financial Services Adjudicator Bill* [B.10 – 2018] as a whole.
