SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The National Council reserves the right:

- (a) to split the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) to accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) to cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the items mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) The Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration
- (b) the List of Goods and Price Schedule Section III;
- (c) the Specifications and Compliance Sheet in Section V; and
- (d) any other attachment deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Sealed Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The Quotation validity period shall be 30 days from the date of submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) have a valid certified company Registration certificate specifying shareholders, as certified by a Commissioner of Oath appointed in terms of the Justice of the Peace and Commissioner of Oaths Act, 1996 (Act No 16 of 1963);
- (b) have an original valid **Good Standing Tax Certificate** or Certified copy as certified by a Commissioner of Oath appointed in terms of the Justice of the Peace and Commissioner of Oaths Act, 1963 (Act No 16 of 1963). Certificate must be valid as at the date of bid submission;
- (c) have an original valid **Good Standing Social Security Certificate** or a printout of valid electronic or online document issued in terms of the Electronic Transaction Act, 2019 (Act No 4 of 2019), subject to the authentication or validation of such printout by a public entity during the bid evaluation process, in accordance with authentication or

- validation guidelines of the issuing authority. /Certificate must be valid as at the date of bid submission;
- (d) have a valid certified copy of **Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate**, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998. - (j) Submit certified identity copies of the shareholders NOT for Company Directors (certification should not be older than six (6) months).
- (k) The bidder must submit a complete bidding document as issued (incomplete bidding documents will not be considered).
- (l) The principle business should be in line with the nature of service required.
- (m) Submit at least two (2) reference letters for leasing of photocopiers that were undertaken by the bidder during the last two (2) years.
- (n) Must have qualified and experienced IT technician(s) employed for servicing of the photocopiers.
- (o) A bidder that is under a declaration of ineligibility by the Government of Namibia in accordance with applicable laws at the date and the deadline for the submission or thereafter, shall be disqualified;

5. Bid Securing Declaration

6. Delivery

Delivery shall be fifteen (15) working days after acceptance/issue of Purchase Order/notice of award. Deviation in delivery period shall not be accepted /shall only be considered if such deviation is reasonable.

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the National Council with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation Bid Box located at National Council, Ground Floor not later than <u>Wednesday</u>, the 12 June 2024, at 10h00. Quotations by post or hand delivered should reach Parliament- National Council, Private Bag 13371, Windhoek by the same date and time. Late quotations will be rejected.

9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the National Council immediately after the closing time referred to in instruction 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the bidders, the amount quoted, the presence or absence of a Bid Securing Declaration, will be posted on the website of the National Council and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

10. Evaluation of Ouotations

The National Council shall have the right to request for clarifications in writing during evaluation. Offers that are substantially responsive shall be compared on the basis of price or ownership cost, subject to Margin of Preference where applicable, to determine the lowest evaluated quotation.

11. Technical Compliance

Bidders shall submit along with their quotations documents, catalogues and any other literature to substantiate compliance with the required specifications and to qualify deviations if any with respect to National Council's requirements.

The Specifications, Performance Requirements and Compliance Sheet details the minimum specifications of the goods/items to be supplied. The specifications have to be met but no credit will be given for exceeding the specifications.


