#### 1. Purchaser

The Public Entity inviting the Informal Quotation is the Purchaser for the purpose of entering into contract with the successful bidder.

#### 2. Supplier

The Bidder having submitted the lowest price and whose offer is substantially responsive to the requirements specified shall be selected for award of contract and referred to as the Supplier.

#### 3. Rights of the Public Entity

The Purchaser shall have the right to

- (a) Ask for clarifications at time of evaluating quotations,
- (b) Split the contract on an item basis or
- (c) Reject all quotations.

A Purchaser shall not be bound to accept the lowest or any quotation.

#### 4. Eligibility Criteria

- (a) have a valid **company Registration Certificate** specifying shareholders or copy Certified by a Commissioner of Oath appointed in terms of the Justice of the Peace and Commissioner of Oaths Act, 1963 (Act No 16 of 1963) clear indicate ownership;
- (b) have an original valid Good Standing Tax Certificate or copy Certified by a Commissioner of Oath appointed in terms of the Justice of the Peace and Commissioner of Oaths Act, 1963 (Act No 16 of 1963). Certificate must be valid for the period specified in the SBD after the bid submission deadline;

- (d) have a valid certified copy of Affirmative Action Compliance Certificate, proof from Employment Equity Commissioner that bidder is not a relevant employer, or exemption issued in terms of Section 42 of the Affirmative Action Act, 1998. Certificate must be valid for the period specified in the SBD after the bid submission deadline;
- (e) have a certificate indicating SME Status (for Bids reserved for SMEs)
- (f) Submit a duly completed and signed Bid-securing Declaration.
- (g) An undertaking on the part of the Bidder that the salaries and wages payable to its personnel in respect of this proposal are compliant to the relevant laws, Remuneration Order, and Award, where applicable and that it will abide to sub-clause 4.6 of the General conditions of Contract if it is awarded the contract or part thereof.;

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(h) The bidder must submit a detailed quotation on its company letter head with the banking details clearly visible on the quote in addition to Section III List of Goods and Price Schedule.

(i) The principle business should be in line with office supplies.

(j) Each page of the bid document must be signed (where applicable) and initialed by such person (s) legally authorized to sign on behalf of the company.

(k) The bidder must submit a complete bidding document as issued (incomplete bidding documents will not be considered). All blank spaces on the standard bidding document must be completed.

#### 5. Bid Securing Declaration

Bidders are required to subscribe to a Bid Securing Declaration for this procurement process. The bidder shall furnish as part of its quotation, a Bid Securing Declaration as per the format contained in Schedule 1 of this document

#### 6. Prices

Prices shall be quoted in Namibia Dollars. Prices quoted shall be firm and fixed during validity period of quotation and for execution of contract.

#### 7. The Contract

The letter of Acceptance/Purchaser Order Form as the case may be together with this Informal Quotation form shall constitute the contract between the Public Entity and the Supplier.

#### 8. Purchase order

A supplier to whom a purchase order is issued must confirm the purchase order within three days of receipt of the purchase order and;

- (a) may not change or alter the terms of the purchase order; and
- (b) must undertake to deliver the goods on or before the date set in the purchase order for delivery of the goods.
- (c) the purchase order shall be valid for ninety (90) days only and will be cancelled thereafter.

#### 9. General Conditions of Contract

The general terms and conditions shall be as per the General Conditions of Contract (Goods) Ref. No.- G/RFQ-GCC posted in the website of the Policy Unit and on the [insert public entities name] website.

#### 10. Warranty

- (a) The Supplier warrants that the goods shall conform to the standards, specifications and related services as defined by the Purchaser in its Invitation for Informal Quotation subject to any alternative proposal made by the Supplier in its response to the Purchaser's Invitation for Informal Quotation.
